



The conduction of external Academic & Administrative Audit was finalized on 22-02-2024 to 23-02-2024. The external AAA committee was assisted by the IQAC members for conducting the audit. On the first day of the audit Committee had a formal meeting with the Vice Chancellor, Directors/Head during which Vice Chancellor presented the overview of the university, developments and the achievements made. Members of the Committee were briefed about the objective of the audit and the procedure involved.

The members visited the affiliated colleges, its infrastructural facilities in the School such as classrooms, laboratories and interacted with the teaching staff and non-teaching staff to know the academic and administrative performance. All the related documents were presented to the members. After completing all stages of inspection and interactions in the school. AAA report covering the observations was prepared for the respective schools by the member.

The members visited the central facilities such as examination cell, library and auditorium and had interactions with the coordinators of the committees/cells operational in the university. Other general facilities like sewage treatment plant etc were also verified. The Committee after completing all stages of inspection and interactions prepared the university AAA report covering all the summarized observations and recommendations.

Action Taken Report After Academic Audit

Subject: Action Taken to Improve Student Participation in Extracurricular Activities and Outreach Programs in Remote Areas of Jharkhand — Academic Audit Report

Reference: Academic Audit Report presented in Academic Council Meeting and subsequently approved by Governing Body of YBN University, Ranchi, Jharkhand.

Audit Observation:

It was observed during the Academic Audit that student participation in extracurricular activities and community outreach programs in remote areas of Jharkhand was less than desirable. This was due to limited awareness, financial constraints, and logistical challenges in organizing and participating in such programs.

Action Taken:

In view of the above observation, the following measures have been implemented:

Awareness Sessions:

Organized workshops and seminars to highlight the importance of extracurricular engagement and community service in developing interpersonal skills, civic responsibility, and holistic education.

Formation of Student Clubs and Cells:

Established Student Activity Clubs and an Outreach Cell within each department to enable systematic planning and execution of community programs in remote areas of Jharkhand.

Financial Support and Incentives:

The University has decided to provide financial aid, certificates of participation, and additional incentives (such as extra credit points) to motivate and recognize students who voluntarily contribute to these initiatives.

Collaborations with Local NGOs:

Collaborated with recognized NGOs and community organizations to facilitate training, health camps, education drives, and other developmental programs in villages and remote settlements. Activity to adopted villages are increased with deferent setups like, LegalAid clinic, Health Camp, Awareness Survey, Classes for Weaker Students, etc



Approval by Academic Council and Governing Body:

This Action Taken Report was presented to the Academic Council meeting held on 05th April and subsequently placed before the Governing Body of YBN University, Ranchi, Jharkhand for approval. The proposal was unanimously approved, reflecting the institution's strong commitment toward holistic education and community engagement.

Conclusion:

YBN University, Ranchi, is dedicated to developing well-rounded graduates who are socially responsible, empathetic, and civic minded. This Action Taken Report forms a crucial step toward strengthening the role of students in community service and extending the reach of education to the most vulnerable and remote areas of Jharkhand.

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
