**Visitors and staff** often travel from far-off villages and urban centers, facing difficulty in accessing hygienic and nutritious food during university hours.

**YBN University** is located in a semi rural/remote region of Jharkhand, where access to affordable and hygienic meals is limited. Many non-teaching staff travel long distances and face financial and logistical challenges in arranging food during working hours.

This situation called for an inclusive and dignified solution that aligns with the university's vision of social responsibility and equity.

Recognizing this concern, the **IQAC of YBN University** initiated **"Food for Everyone"**, a non commercial, value-based meal service, to provide free meals during working hours without discrimination or the need for identification.



The initiative was approved by the competent authority in the first phase, targeting non teaching staff who were most affected.

Under the banner of "Food for Everyone", a clean and hygienic food distribution point was set up on campus.

**No ID card, discrimination, or registration is required** — the service is value-driven and open during official hours.

Meals are served daily, including rice, pulses, seasonal vegetables, and safe drinking water.

A dedicated food distribution center has been set up within the campus, managed by a **volunteer team of staff**, **students**, **and kitchen staff**.

Nutritious vegetarian meals are prepared and served during the Breakfast, lunch and dinner hours daily.

The initiative runs All Day in Week, covering all academic working days.

The initiative is supported by **university funds**, and **partially by donations from faculty, alumni, and well-wishers**.

Strict hygiene and food safety standards are followed.

No registration, tokens, or conditions are required. **Anyone on campus** can eat free of cost.

The practice promotes dignity and self-respect — there is **no publicity or forced acknowledgment.**

- Timings were extended slightly to accommodate faculty and visitors without disrupting academic schedules.


